



## Terms and Conditions for the Fairly Fashionable Challenge 2015

This document sets out the terms of participation in the Fairly Fashionable Challenge 2015.

1. The promoter of this Competition is the Fair Trade Freo Group and the WA Fair Trade Collective.
2. Entry to the Competition is open to designers from Australia. However, entrants attending the Fashion Show of finalist entries at their own expense, no travel or accommodation costs will be covered for interstate entrants. Entries may be posted, however cost of return must be covered by designer and the pieces must be received by the deadline.
3. Each entrant can only submit one entry. A maximum of two people can submit an entry together. Where two people have submitted a collaborative entry, any awarded will be shared equally amongst them.
4. The piece must be designed and made by the person/people named on the entry form.
5. Each entry must be 'wearable' and incorporate the piece of fair trade fabric supplied in some manner. Please note – the supplied fabric will be unlikely to be sufficient to complete a whole garment or fashion item. It will likely be used as an inspiration or feature piece. Other fabrics and finishings may be used – but these must have a Fairtrade, organic, upcycled or ethical lineage which can be proven.
6. Entrants will be categorised according to their level of expertise. The categories will be Professional, Amateur and Student designers. Please detail your level in your expression of interest.
7. Entry into the Competition is free.

8. The Competition opens 25<sup>th</sup> March 2013 when Expressions of Interest are called and runs until 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2015 when the Exhibition closes.
9. Fabric collection location will be confirmed by email two weeks prior to the challenge launch.
10. The Expression of Interest entry period closes at 5pm (WST) on March 25<sup>th</sup> 2015.
11. To enter the Competition, you must:
  - (i) Submit an Expression of Interest via the online form available at [www.fairlyfashionable.com.au](http://www.fairlyfashionable.com.au) by March 25<sup>th</sup> 2015.
  - (ii) Collect a piece of Fair Trade Fabric at the launch on April 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - (iii) Incorporate that piece of fabric into a wearable fashion design item (note: this item does not necessarily have to be clothing – accessories are also acceptable – i.e. handbags, hats, jewellery).
  - (iv) Submit and deliver your design to Bibi, 70 High Street, Fremantle between 9am and 5pm.
  - (v) Submit and deliver with your design description according to the template provided at the launch on April 1<sup>st</sup>. These will be used by the MC as part of the Fashion Show announcements.
  - (vi) Attend the Fashion Show (non-essential but advisable) on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> April 6.30pm
  - (vii) Collect your design from Bibi 70 High Street, Fremantle between 9am and 5pm on May 11<sup>th</sup>.
12. Designers are not required to donate their design to the Promoter, however should the designer wish to do so designs will be auctioned to raise funds for a nominated charity via a silent auction held throughout the Exhibition period.
13. Your design may not be altered at any time by the Promoter.
14. Awards will be given to each category winner for the best, most original and creative entry. Chance plays no part in determining the award winners.

15. By submitting your design you warrant that:

- (i) all details provided with your entry are true and accurate;
- (ii) you have all necessary rights and licences to grant the rights set out in these Terms and Conditions;
- (iii) your design is solely your own and has not been previously communicated to the public;
- (iv) the exercise of the rights granted to the Promoter in these Terms and Conditions will not infringe the rights of any third parties; and you will indemnify the Promoter against any loss or damage resulting from any breach of these warranties.

16. Decisions of the Promoter and its panel of judges are final and will be binding on each person who enters the Competition and no correspondence will be entered into.

17. If there is any event that prevents or hinders the Promoter's conduct of the Competition or the Promoter's ability to deliver the prize/s to the prize winner/s of the Competition, the Promoter may, in its discretion, cancel the Competition and recommence it at another time under the same conditions or select another winner.

18. The details on the Expression of Interest and application form will only be used for the purposes of this competition and the related promotion. Your private information will not be given to any individual or organisation or third party without your prior permission.

19. The Promoter may use your entry photos, or photos or video of you, your entry and models wearing your design at the Fashion Show event in print or web media, for promotional purposes associated with this competition and any future related competitions. Copyright belongs to the creator of the image or video. The intellectual property for your design remains with you.

20. The Promoter cannot accept liability for any loss of or damage to finalists' outfits during the Parade or temporary public displays, or during travel to or from the Fashion Show/

Exhibition or other sites of display. The Promoter will take all reasonable care to safeguard outfits whilst they are in its custody.

21. To the full extent permitted by the law, the Promoter will not be liable for any injury, damages, expenses, or loss whatsoever (whether direct or inconsequential) to persons or property as a result of any person entering into the Competition or accepting or using any prize, including without limitation non-receipt of any prize or damage to any prize in transit.
22. Each entry must be entered in accordance with these Terms and Conditions. By entering the Competition, each entrant agrees to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. The Promoter may in its discretion refuse to award any prize to any entrant who fails to comply with these Terms and Conditions. All relevant instructions on the Promoter's website form part of these Terms and Conditions.
